#### **I) Accredited**

Nashotah House Theological Seminary – Nashotah Wisconsin

Trinity School for Ministry – Ambridge, PA

Reformed Episcopal Seminary – Blue Bell, PA

St. Francis College of Theology, Wusasa, Zaria, Nigeria

#### **II) Unaccredited\***

Cranmer House Theological Seminary – Houston

(Reformed Episcopal Church – a member of ACNA)

Davenant Hall (MLitt with an Anglican Studies track. They have an agreement with an accredited UK University for acceptance into doctoral studies in a research program)

Ridley Institute (Certificate in Anglican Studies for those with a non-Anglican Seminary Degree) (can receive accredited credit through Gordon Conwell).

Greystone Institute. They have an Anglican Studies program with good faculty and cooperation with Westminster Theological Seminary

#### **III) Accredited with Anglican Studies Track**

Reformed Theological Seminary (Anglican Studies track at DC campus)

Gordon Conwell Theological Seminary (Anglican studies available at Jacksonville campus)

Beeson Divinity School Birmingham, AL (Anglican studies track)

## IV) Other

### Asbury Theological Seminary

Seminary studies plan on a case by case basis\*\*

\*Unaccredited is an option but there are potential drawbacks. Speak with the Bishop or Executive Archdeacon

\*\*It is possible to devise a plan of study in cooperation with the Bishop and Executive Archdeacon that includes another Evangelical Seminary supplemented by Anglican studies courses. For example, Liberty University and Regents in Virginia have Regional and ATS accreditation and distance learning, campus, and blended studies available. The candidate would then need to take specific Anglican courses from an approved seminary. It is advised that you do not enroll in a non-approved Seminary prior to getting it approved by the Diocese.
